Uncontested Election

Should **5** or fewer valid nominations be received by the closing date, the uncontested election meeting will take place on **11th March 2026 and will begin at 7pm in Broomhill Primary School, 57 Edgehill Rd, Glasgow G11 7HZ**.

Contested Election

Should more valid nominations be submitted to Glasgow City Council by the above closing date than there are vacancies, a secret ballot will take place on a date to be determined.

3. All persons aged over **16 years** and resident in the Community Council area are entitled to vote in elections.
 4. All proposers and seconds must also be resident in the Community Council area and aged over **16** years.
 5. Candidates, proposers and seconds names should appear on the Electoral Register (alternative measures for identification status of candidates may be undertaken in certain circumstances).

Term of Office

6. Successful candidates elected to serve on the Community Council, will do so until the next scheduled full election to be held in **October 2027**.
7. If you submit a Nomination Form, Glasgow City Council staff will contact you to confirm the validity of your nomination and will inform you at the close of nominations if a contested election is to take place.
